


## A pattern of paediatric facility

Embarking on a paediatric facility project the aspiration for all involved is that the safest, most comfortable setting will be created, in which patients would receive the best care. If we consider hospitals to be daunting places for most adults, for children it can be much worse. Designers of different specialties collaborate to make the most of any opportunity to 'demedicalise' the premises and provide a







less institutional feel.

In the case of **GOSH's Italian Building** it was a thread of familial domesticity that is employed as an inspiration to the scheme. The original Hospital was first opened in pair of houses, and the proposals aim to replicate the warm, homely feel of a big house with an inviting garden.
